October 10, 2017

- 1. The meeting was called to order at 8:00 a.m. by Chairman Marty Danzer, in the office of the Carroll County Recycling Center. Others in attendance were Dr. Eric Jensen, City of Carroll; Mike Schwabe, City of Breda; and Jeff Anthofer, City of Coon Rapids. Also attending were Bob Muhlbauer, Commission CPA; Mary Wittry, Director and Dan Halbur, Office Manager.
- 2. Agenda: Schwabe made the motion to approve the agenda and Anthofer seconded. Motion carried, all voting aye.
- 3. Dr. Jensen made the motion and Schwabe seconded to approve the minutes of the Executive Board meeting on September 11, 2017. Motion carried, all voting aye.
- 4. Danzer reviewed the Bills Payable--see attached. Wittry went over the following: Bomgaars--\$1071.53—pallet of filters, hi viz shirts, and supplies; Employment Resources--\$10973.72—2 months New Hope labor; Foth --\$42422.54—2 months: general consulting, sampling, storm water pollution prevention, single stream feasibility study, and life cycle analysis; Haley Implement--\$1735.00—protection plan; TestAmerica Laboratories--\$7306.50—spring and fall sampling. Anthofer made the motion and Dr. Jensen seconded to approve the bills as presented. Motion carried, all voting aye.
- 5. Halbur presented the financial report --see attached. Anthofer made the motion and Dr. Jensen seconded to approve the financial report as presented. Motion carried, all voting aye.
- 6. Bob Muhlbauer provided an overview of the preliminary draft June 30, 2017 audit. The final draft audit will be presented at the November meeting.
- 7. The leachate forcemain and sanitary sewer project was completed and fully operational on September 19, 2017.
- 8. Single steam study update: Wittry informed the board that 3 stakeholder meetings have been conducted and the design and study results will be presented in November.
- 9. Conference updates: Wittry discussed topics from Wastecon in Baltimore and the Fall Conference in Coralville. Wittry also informed the board that Carroll County Solid Waste Management Commission & the City of Carroll were awarded the "Outstanding Facility/Program Award" for "Outstanding Leachate Management Facility/Program" at the Fall Conference.
- 10. Landfill update: Wittry informed the board there has been no inmates for two weeks due to wet conditions and that fall sampling has been completed.
- 11. Recycling update: Wittry informed the board that prices are down.
