LITHIUM



Lithium batteries are commonly known as button batteries due to their small size. They are found in hearing aids, watches, computer mother boards, car remotes, greeting cards, vaping & e-cig, solar lights.

NICKLE/METAL HYDRIDE (NI-MH)



These are rechargeable batteries and are similar in size and shape to alkaline batteries. (A, AA, AAA, C, D) They can be identified by the words "RECHARGABLE" or "Ni-MH."

MERCURY & SILVER OXIDE



These tiny batteries are becoming rare, but may still be found in older equipment. They are similar in appearance to lithium batteries, just smaller.

NICKLE - CADMIUM (NI-CAD)



This is a common rechargeable battery found in many devices, but most common in power tools. They come in a variety of shapes and sizes.
