Recycling plastics is a simple yet impactful way to reduce the amount of waste that goes into the landfill. Food safe plastics labeled with the numbers 1 (PETE), 2 (HDPE), and 5 (PP) are all recyclable.

#1 - PETE

#2-HDPE



- Laundry Detergent Jugs
- Bleach Containers
- Vinegar Jugs
- Shampoo Bottles
- Conditioner Bottles
- Lotion Bottles

#5 - PP



- Yogurt Containers
- Butter Containers
- Sour Cream Containers
- Cottage Cheese Containers
- Many Disposable Plastic Cups
- Frozen Food Trays
